# **DAY CAMPS**

**Regular Day Camp** 

For children having completed Pre-K through 6th grade
Pre-school children must be 3 yrs by 6/1/2010 and potty trained
Monday through Friday 9AM — 4 PM

**Dates:** June 21 through August 20 (wk. of July 5 closed Mon.7/5)

**Cost:** \$215.00 per week (wk. of July 5 - \$172.00)

Register for one week or multiple weeks using event numbers shown on calendar page.

Children who come for just one week or all summer will experience a wide variety of themes and activities. Campers will enjoy arts and crafts, hiking, nature study, animals, music, games, Bible study, outdoor sports, and swimming, in a caring Christian environment. All programming is age appropriate. Additional activities may include: drama, newspaper, sports, board games, art, and group building activities. Lunch and a morning snack are provided each day.

#### **Extended Care**

Available for children attending the Regular Day Camp Program or Disciple Program.

Only children registered for extended care or Creative Camp Options may be on site before 9AM or after 4PM.

Before Care hours: 7:00AM - 9:00AM | After Care hours: 4:00PM - 6:00PM | Both Before and After Care Cost: \$35.00 (week of July 5 - \$28) | Cost: \$35.00 (week of July 5 - \$40)

Register for one week or multiple weeks using event numbers shown on calendar page.

Parents have the opportunity to choose either Before or After Care hours, or both if desired. Children attending Before Care will have a quiet playtime in the Lodge from 7—8 and then will go outside (weather permitting) for free-time play. Outdoor play will include the use of the blacktop and field in front of the lodge. After Care will be held outdoors (weather permitting) and will also provide free-time activities. The After Care activities include the use of the black top, playground, basketball, ga-ga and other group and individual activities under the watchful care of CSF staff.

## **Pre-school Half-Day Program**

For children who have not yet gone to Kindergarten

Pre-school children must be 3 yrs by 6/1/2010 and potty trained Monday through Friday 9AM — 12:15 PM

**Dates:** June 21 through August 20 (wk. of July 5 closed Mon. 7/5)

**Cost:** \$110.00 per week (wk. of July 5 - \$88.00)

Register for one week or multiple weeks using event numbers shown on calendar page.

Each session is unique and has all the elements of our full day program, programmed with the pre-schooler in mind! A morning snack is provided each day.



\*For all options, cost will be adjusted if camper is registered for any other extended care that week.

## **Basketball**

For children and youth completed grades 3-5 & 6-8

Monday through Friday 4 to 6PM Dates: July 12-16 Cost: \$70.00\*

For the basketball lover. Led by local high school coaches, participants will brush up on skills, run drills, and play 3-on-3 and 5-on-5 games. All equipment will be provided.

#### Art

For children and youth completed grades 4 – 8

Monday through Friday 4 to 6PM **Dates:** August 2-6

Cost: \$70.00\*

Campers will explore multiple art mediums. Fine for beginners or those with experience. Led by college art majors. All supplies included.

#### Soccer

For children completed grades 1 - 3 & 4 - 6

Monday through Friday 4 to 6PM Dates: July 26-30 Cost: \$70.00\*

For those who love to play soccer and want to play more. Led by local high school coaches, participants will learn skills, run drills, and play games. All equipment will be provided.

#### **Guard Start**

For children and youth ages 11 - 14

Monday through Friday 4 to 6PM **Dates:** August 9-13 **Cost:** \$70.00\*

The Red Cross Guard Start Program is an introduction to pool safety, basic CPR, spotting, and beginner guard techniques. This program is used to develop interest in taking the full Lifesaving course when students turn 15. Each student will receive a workbook. Led by CSF Pool Staff.

# **Pre-Teen Overnight Option**

For pre-teens who have finished grades 5-6

**Dates:** July 19-23 **Cost:** \$40.00\* **Maximum:** 25 girls, 25 boys

This camp is a chance for the older campers to spend a couple of nights together in the midst of the summer day camp program. Campers will register for the **Day Camp 905** program for the week and then add the overnight option. The boys will stay overnight on Monday and Tuesday, and the girls will stay Wednesday and Thursday nights. The program in the evenings will include night swims, bonfires, games, and devotions.
