Kids Can Camp

Dates: June 28 – July 2, Monday 10:15AM through Friday 4:30PM

Cost: \$270 **Capacity:** 15

Kids Can Camp provides an overnight camping experience for children ages 8 – 12 diagnosed with high functioning autism, Asperger's syndrome or are mentally challenged, and are functioning at a life skills level or higher. Daily activities will include Bible time, swim lessons, arts & crafts, games, outdoor education, afternoon swim time, night swims, snacks, delicious meals, hikes, visiting farm animals, making new friends, singing, sleeping in dormitory-style bunks, and much more.

Campers interested in this exciting overnight camp need to be completely toilet trained, and have good self-help skills (eating, toileting, showering, brushing teeth and hair with minimal supervision).

Opportunities for Youth and Adults

Cornerstone Youth Leadership – Disciple Program

For youth having completed grades 7 – 11

Youth must call for an application packet. Parent cannot register their child for this program.

Maximum 30 youths per week.

Monday – Friday 9AM – 4PM

Dates: June 21 through August 20 (week of 7/5 closed Mon. 7/5)

Cost: \$95.00 per week (wk. of 7/5 - \$76.00)

Extended hours available – see Extended Care and Creative Camp Options information.

The Disciple Program is a beginning leadership experience.

Youth must make a commitment of at least 3 weeks, but may serve for more. Youth will experience serving as helpers to the counselors, will plan program events and participate in mission projects. The Disciples have their own Bible Study time apart from the campers and staff daily, as well as other opportunities for interaction as a group throughout the summer. This program is designed to challenge youth to grow spiritually, learn to serve others and be young men and women of good character. Youth may stay in this program a maximum of three years.



- **Acceptance into the program is determined through an application and interview process.**
- **To start the process, the youth must contact Carson-Simpson Farm themselves and request an application packet. Applications must be returned to the camp by April 1.**
- **A mandatory training event is scheduled for May 14 and 15 for those who have completed all of the application process.**

Cost: \$40

Date: June 15 – 5:30 – 6:30PM raindate 6/16

Proof of original certification required.
